OTHER ITEMS

Modification of WRC Art. 27.2

This article will be not taken into consideration.

Clarification of WRC Art.66.3.5

Cars entered by a Manufacturer or Manufacturer Team must be equipped with only new tyres (<u>including spare wheels</u>) at the exit of each service except when no special stage is involved.

'Meet the Crews'

The top 3 drivers classified at the end of Days 1 and 2 must attend a 'Meet the Crews' session for media and spectators. This will take place at the 'WRC stage' in the service park at a time advised to the teams by the FIA Media Delegate. Other selected drivers and team personnel must make themselves available to attend these sessions if requested by the FIA Media Delegate.

Autograph signing session

Up to 5 crew or team members must make themselves available for a 15 minute autograph signing session at the end of Days 1 and 2. This will take place at the 'WRC stage' in the service park at a time advised to those selected by the WRC Promoter.

ROAD BOOK

On Day 3, Non-priority drivers, not using FIA fuel, are allowed to use REPSOL fuel station located on road C-44, 100 m. left from the junction with T-304 (Road book page 142, box 9). These drivers will be allowed to turn left for refuelling only and then rejoin the rally route.
