ENTRIES

3.1 Entry procedure

Anyone wishing to take part in the 44 RallyRACC Catalunya-COSTA DAURADA / Rally de España 2008 must send the official entry form published on the rally website. www.rallyracc.com, under the section "Competitors/Forms" duly completed, to the rally office (address details in Art. 2.4 of the present regulations) before the entry closing date.

Manufacturers and Manufacturers Teams entered in the FIA WRC and competitors in the FIA Junior WRC shall use the entry form supplied by the FIA.

Thursday, 28th August 2008, at 14.00 h. Closing date for entries:

Details concerning the co-driver must be lodged prior to Wednesday, 3rd September 2008.

The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- Photocopies of the Competitor and Drivers Competitions licences.
- Photocopies of the Drivers passport or Identity cards.
- One passport photo for driver and co-driver.
- ☐ Photocopy of the page of the car homologation form for the entered car where are indicated number, group and cylinder.

For foreign competitors, the entry form must be stamped by the competitors National Sporting Authority (International Sporting Code Art. 17 and 70), or enclose an authorisation letter from their National Sporting Authority giving permission to participate in the 44 RallyRACC Catalunya-COSTA DAURADA 2008.

If the entry form is sent by fax or e-mail, the original must reach the Organisers at the latest one week after the close of entries.

3.2 Number of entrants accepted and classes

3.2.1 Number of entrants

The maximum number of entrants accepted will be 90 cars.

If more than 90 entries are received the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

No entry can be guaranteed before the entries closing date. Organisers will inform the crews which entry form has been not accepted after this date.

3.2.2 Classes

• Production Cars (Group N) including Super 2000 cars:

- 3.2.4 A minimum number of five starters per class are admitted: should this number not be attained, the competitors in the class concerned are admitted in the next class up.

3.3 Entry fees

- c) Drivers participating with Spanish licence. To encourage Spanish drivers to participate to the Spanish round of the World Rally Championship, RACC will assume the 50% of the entry fees of the Spanish drivers participating with Spanish licence.

3.5 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- In case of the rally not taking place.
- Organisers may refund the 30% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN) were unable to start the rally.

4. INSURANCE

4.1 Description of the insurance cover

According to the existing Regulations in Spain the insurance policy arranged by the Organisers covers the guarantees required by the R.F.E. de A.:

- 4.1.1 Liability to third parties in accordance with Spanish legislation.
- 4.1.2 For personal injury up to a limit of 70 million euros per occurence
- 4.1.3 For property damage up to a limit of 15 million euros per occurence

The insurance cover will come into effect during the official itinerary of the rally and will cease at the end of the Event (at the opening of the final parc ferme) or at the moment of retirement, disqualification or exclusion. Vehicles taking part at the shakedown will be also covered by this policy.

- 4.2 In case of an accident, the competitor or his representative must notify in writing the Clerk of the Course in as short a time as possible and in a maximum of 24 hours. He must explain the circumstances under which the accident occurred. Likewise he must mention the names and addresses of any witnesses.
- 4.3 Only damage caused by the Organisers and the entered drivers is covered by the insurance policy taken out by the Organisation. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars is not covered by this insurance.
- 4.4 Entrants and competitors are free to take out any individual insurance policy that they deem fit, independently from the above mentioned liability insurance.
- 4.5 In case of an accident, competitors and drivers agree to hold harmless and keep indemnified the event's promoters and Organisers against all claims.
- 4.6 The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, may never be considered as official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

5. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

5.1 Organiser's advertising

Competition numbers, rally plates and organisers advertising will be provided by the Organisers and must be affixed as specified in accordance with Articles IX and X of the 2008 General Prescriptions. Details concerning advertising are described in Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations.

5.2 Identification numbers

Competition numbers and rally plates will be affixed on the car before scrutineering and these must be visible through the duration of the rally.

5.3 Restrictions in Spain

From January 13, 2007, all advertising or sponsorship of tobacco products on clothing, complements, instruments, equipment, prototypes and/or vehicles of teams participating in motor sports competitions or events is banned by law.

6. TYRES

All tyres must comply with the current FIA regulations, Art.18 of 2008 World Rally Championship Sporting Regulations.

- 6.1 **PIRELLI** has been nominated by the FIA as the single tyre supplier to distribute the tyres for the rallies in the Championship.
- **6.2** All drivers entering a 4WD car or entered in FIA Junior WRC must use PIRELLI tyres.

6.3 Tyres for non-priority drivers:

- For 2WD: must use tyres in conformity with Appendix J.
- For 4WD: must use Pirelli tyres and be conform with Article 18 and Appendix V from 2008 WRC Sporting Regulations
- Any Competitor not entered in the Junior WRC and taking part with a Super 1600 car must respect Article 8 – Tyres applicable to the Junior WRC regulations, with the exception of tyre make which is free.

6.5 PIRELLI supply information for non-priority drivers:

- Competitors are not required to order tyres. Pirelli will transport a number of tyres calculated on the maximum number allowed for each competitor.
- Only tyres directly leased by Pirelli at the event are allowed.
- Pirelli will install a distribution center in the Service park from Tuesday 30th September to lease tyres to all Competitors.
- At the end of the event (at Pirelli distribution center, located in the RallyRACC Service park) <u>Competitors shall return ALL tyres delivered by Pirelli.</u>
- Only the tyres used during the event will be invoiced.
- Price of asphat tyres, each: 240 euros (+ taxes)
- Payment: Credit card ONLY (VISA, MASTERCARD & AMERICAN EXPRESS).
- Competitors are requested to complete the "Pirelli Form" (Team Company details) in order to provide to Pirelli invoicing information. 7. FUEL

7.1 Order procedure

Competitors must comply with 2008 WRC Sporting regulations Art. 25.

7.1.1 All FIA priority drivers must use FIA fuel

All competitors must place their fuel order before Thursday 11th September 2008. An order form is available on the official RallyRACC site www.rallyracc.com under the section Competitors / Forms.

7.1.2 Non-priority drivers

Non-priority drivers may either use FIA fuel, following the same conditions and rules as the priority drivers, or may use commercial available pump fuel, dispensed only from pumps at filling stations marked in the Road Book.

7.2 Distribution during the Rally

Refuel zones for all priority drivers and for all non-priority drivers using FIA fuel will be established as follow:

Day 1 Refuel: PortAventura (immediately after TC – Service out)

Remote refuel: Valls

Day 2 Refuel: PortAventura (immediately after TC – Service out)

Remote Refuel: La Granadella

Day 3 Refuel: PortAventura (immediately after TC – Service out)

Remote Refuel: Vandellós

8. RECONNAISSANCE

8.1 Procedure to carry out the reconnaissance

- 8.1.1 Reconnaissance must be carried out with cars conforming to Art.14.3 (FIA General Prescriptions 2008).
- 8.1.2 Organisers will give a reconnaissance vehicle identification sticker (see art. 8.1.3 of these present regulations) and a time card valid for up to 2 passages over each special stage. These will be send together with Road-Book, Rally Guide 2, rally maps and all rally official documents to all entrants from Friday 5th September 2008.

With these documents, **all** crews are authorised to start reconnaissance on **Tuesday**, **30**th **September 2008. Any** pre-reconnaissance registration at Rally HQ is not requested.

8.1.3 Entrants carrying out reconnaissance must do so in accordance with the schedule mentioned in Appendix 2 and according to the following list of colours.

Yellow sticker: FIA priority 1 & 2
 Red sticker: FIA priority 3
 Blue sticker: Non seeded drivers

Reconnaissances sticker must be affixed during reconnaissances on the **top right** of the front windscreen.

8.1.4 Special stages will be supervised by rally officials and competitors must follow their instructions.

During reconnaissances crews must stop at the start of each stage, which will be duly signposted. Rally Officials will be positioned at the start and the finish of each special stage. Rally Officials will stamp the reconnaissances time card in order to record every run on each special stage.

8.1.5 Any driver with a view to taking part in the following year's World Rally Championship may take part in the reconnaissances of the event. The regulations on reconnaissances must be respected in their entirety and the driver must pay a fee of 1,000 €.

8.2 Schedule

8.2.1 Reconnaissance for all drivers will take place on *Tuesday 30th September and Wednesday 1st October 2008*, from 08.00hrs to 19.00hrs.

The programme in Appendix 2 must be fully respected by the crews.

8.2.2 Crews are authorised to <u>drive a maximum of 2 times</u> through each special stage, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the Road Traffic Laws in Spain. In no circumstances may crews drive in the opposite direction of the rally on the special stages.

8.3 Specific and / or national restrictions - speed limit

- 8.3.1 The maximum speed set for the reconnaissance of special stages is 80 km/h, except for those cases in which there are speed limit signals and in built-up areas (50 km/h).
- 8.3.2 It is emphasised **that reconnaissance is not practice**. All the Road Traffic Laws in Spain must be strictly adhered to and the safety and rights of the other road users must be respected.
- 8.3.3 The following fines will be applied by the Clerk of the Course in case of speeding offence:
 - 1st offence: Km per hour over the speed limit

50 € for P1

25 € for P2

13€ for P3

10€ for Non-priority

This fine is levied as per the Regulations. The amount of the fine is unaltered by any fine that may or many not be levied by the Police.

- 2nd offence: Fine doubled for all drivers if 2nd offence committed in either the same or another rally in the same calendar year.

- Suspended exclusion:

From his next event valid for the year if the speed is over 100% the speed limit.

8.3.4 Reconnaissance cars have to be covered by insurance as required by the law, no responsibility being imputable to the Organisers.

8.4 Service during reconnaissance

Service of reconnaissance cars may only be provided by a maximum of 2 technicians per team using a car complying with Art.8.7.1 of WRC regulations and carrying all necessary service equipment on-board. A car pass will be issued by the organiser for this purpose. This vehicle may not travel on the Special Stages for any purpose other than to recover their reconnaissance car.

8.5 Fitment of speed control checking devices

All drivers nominated by the FIA will be required to carry a tracker system unit in their cars. A list with the nominated drivers as well as the locations where the data will be downloaded each evening will be included in a Bulletin.

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Administrative control will take place at Rally HQ - Hotel PortAventura (PortAventura)

9.1 Original documents to be presented

The following items will be checked:

- > Entrants licence: National for Spanish drivers and International for foreign drivers
- Driver and Co-driver competition licences: National for Spanish drivers and International for foreign drivers. Driver and co-driver must present a Driver Competition licence.
- > Driver and Co-driver passports or identity cards
- NSA authorisation, for all foreign competitors
- Completion of all details on the entry form

9.2 Schedule

Monday, 29 ¹¹ September	from 17.00 to 20.00 hrs.
Tuesday, 30 th September	from 09.00 to 13.00 hrs. & from 16.00 to 20.00 hrs.
Wednesday, 1 st October	from 09.00 to 13.00 hrs. & from 16.00 to 18.00 hrs

Competitors may attend administrative control on any of the above 3 days, but must do so before scrutineering.

Competition numbers and rally plates will be delivered during documentation control.

9.3 Tracking Systems will be issued to Competitors at the Administrative checks venue (Rally HQ) at the following time:

- Reconnaissance tracker systems: Monday 29th September, from 18.00 to 20.00 hrs

- Rally Tracker systems: Tuesday 30th September, from 16.00 to 20.00 hrs

10. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

The administrative check must be completed before entering the scrutineering venue.

Competition number, rally plates and advertising stickers shall be affixed on the rally car before entering the Scrutineering venue.

A detailed timetable will be published by means of a bulletin after entries have closed.

10.2 Mud flaps (Appendix J. Art. 252.7.71)

Mud flaps to prevent splashing towards the front, made from flexible material, are authorised to be installed at the front of the vehicle.

10.3 Windows/Nets (Appendix J. Art. 253. 11)

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorised and must comply with this Art.

10.4 HANS – FIA approved head restraint system

Wearing a head restraint approved by the FIA is **mandatory for ALL drivers** participating in 44 RallyRACC Catalunya-COSTA DAURADA / Rally de España 2008.

Details concerning HANS can be found at "Guide for the use of HANS" published by the FIA institute for Motor Sport Safety, FIA website www.fia.com under the heading FIA Sport – Regulations – Drivers' Equipment & Appendix L, chapter III – Drivers' equipment, Art. 3

10.5 Engine sealing

Before scrutineering, all cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials, and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighing.

Since Junior WRC cars are required to have their engines sealed in the same way as World rally cars, it is permitted to change the oil pan under the supervision of a scrutineer.

10.6 Article 20 of the WRC Sporting Regulations 2008 is clarified as follows:

New text = **bold and underlined**

Deleted text = deleted

"20.1 Limitation of the number of Engines"

The maximum number of engine <u>links</u> which may be used on a car at the discretion of the Manufacturer or Manufacturer Team for the year is:

- 5 engine links per Manufacturer's car
- 3 engine <u>links</u> per car for a Manufacturer Team which has nominated 10 championship events.
- 4 engine <u>links</u> per car for a Manufacturer Team which has nominated 11 or 12 Championship events.
- 5 engine <u>links</u> per car for a Manufacturer Team which has nominated 13, 14 and 15 Championship events.

For a Manufacturer or a Manufacturer Team, a list of rallies intended to be run with the same engine (Links) must be notified to the FIA prior to the first rally in which they will take part.

Each engine will be assigned to a competitor's number.

For a Manufacturer Team which has nominated 10 to 12 Rallies, there must be a maximum of 4 Links.

For a Manufacturer Team which has nominated 13 to 15 Rallies, there must be a maximum of 5 Links.

"20.2 Sealing of the engine"

The engine of each car entered by a Manufacturer will be sealed by a scrutineer at the start of the first rally of each Link and must should remain sealed until the end of the final rally of the link

These seals may be destroyed only in the following cases, without penalty:

- Change of oil pan (only under the supervision of a scrutineer).
- If the car does not finish the first or the second Rally of a Link, (the <u>either a</u> new engine will be sealed before the start of the next Rally <u>or a previously sealed engine having the seals intact installed</u>). This new engine must remain sealed until the final Rally of the Link –
- If a Manufacturer Team used an engine previously used by a Manufacturer and still sealed.

If the car finishes the first and/or second Rally of a Link (thus appearing in the final classification) and the seals are found to be destroyed before the second or third Rally of the Link (except for a change of oil pan), a 5-minute penalty may will be imposed by the Stewards at the next Rally.

"20.3 Change of an engine"

20.3.1 Between Scrutineering and starting park

For cars entered by a Manufacturer or a Manufacturer Team, in the case of engine failure between scrutineering and the start of the Rally, and only in that case, it will be permitted to replace that engine with a spare engine.

If this engine change takes place during the first rally of a Link, no penalty will be applied. If it takes place during the second or third Rally of a Link, a 5-minute penalty will be applied. Only one spare engine per rally and per Manufacturer is allowed. The identification numbers of the seals must be declared at scrutineering.

"20.3.2 After the start of Day 1"

The change of an engine during a rally after the start of Day 1 is not permitted.

The rest of Article 20 remains unchanged.

10.7 FIA Safety Rally Tracking Systems

The FIA Safety Rally Tracking System must be installed in the cars and in working order before the cars are presented for scrutineering. Installation instructions will be published in Rally Guide 2.

11. FEATURES OF THE RALLY

11.1 Ceremonial start procedure

11.1.1 Ceremonial Start is compulsory for all competing cars and crews and will take place in Salou, Passeig Jaume I, on Thursday 2nd October at 20.00 hrs.

The crews must park their cars in parking zone located at Passeig Jaume I, near by the ceremonial start podium during following times:

P1 & P2
 between 19.00 and 19.30 h.
 between 19.30 and 20.00 h.
 Non-seeded teams
 between 20.00 and 20.30 h.

The cars may be brought by a competitor' representative.

This parking zone will be closed and under vigilance.

- 11.1.2 The Competitors will start the Podium Ceremony in the order of the provisional classification of the WRC. The first P1 team will start at 20.00 hrs.
- 11.1.3 The start interval at the Ceremonial start will be 1 minute for all drivers.
- 11.1.4 No Time Cards will be issued.
- 11.1.5 Competitors must wear their approved overalls.
- 11.1.6 Late arrival at the start ramp up to 15 minutes after a competitor's due time will be penalised at 120 €. Arrival after 15 minutes will be reported to the Stewards. After the Ceremonial Start in Passeig Jaume I (Salou), rally cars are free until presented at TC 0.

11.2 Starting order will be as described in 2008 WRC Sporting regulations Art.13.2

11.3 Start intervals

Start intervals for Days 1, 2 and 3: the first 20 P1 and P2 drivers will have an interval between their start times of 2 minutes. Remaining drivers will have an interval of 1 minute.

11.4 Time card delivery and change during the rally

11.4.1 Time card delivery

There will be no Parc Fermé on Thursday 2nd October.

- Friday, 3rd October Time cards will be collected from the Service Park, close to TC 0, 30 minutes before each car's individual starting time.
- Saturday, 4th and Sunday 5th October Time cards may be collected close to TC 6D and TC 12D respectively (Parc Fermé OUT), 30 minutes before each car's individual starting time.

11.4.2 New Time Cards will be issued at the following Time Controls:

Day 1 – Friday, 3rd October:

TC 3B Regroup Out - PortAventura

TC 6A Parc Fermé IN

TC 6B Parc Fermé OUT Flexi-Service In. Delivery of Time Card for Flexi-Service

Day 2 - Saturday, 4th October:

TC 9B Regroup Out - PortAventura

TC 12A Parc Fermé IN

TC 12B Parc Fermé OUT Flexi-Service In. Delivery of Time Card for Flexi-Service

Day 3 - Sunday, 5th October:

TC 15B Regroup Out - PortAventura

For cars re-starting Days 2 and 3 a time card (for a maximum for 3 hours) will be issued.

11.5 Starting system of special stages

On the special stages the start will be given using the standard ISC-T starting equipment. At 30 seconds to go, an amber light will illuminate the startlights panel. At each of the last five seconds before the start a red light illuminates the startlights panel. At 0 seconds all lights will extinguish, which is the signal to start.

Should the ISC-T start system fail the start will be given as specified in Art.19.5 of the FIA General Prescriptions.

A photocell placed 40cm in front of the starting line will be used to detect jump starts.

11.6 Traffic infringements relating to road sections

The following fines will be applied by the Clerk of the Course, following a police report received after the start of the rally (2008 FIA General Prescriptions Art.11.1.1)

1st infringement: Speeding offence, for each km per hour over the speed limit:

50 € for P1 25 € for P2 13€ for P3 10€ for Non-priority

2nd infringement: A 5-minute time penalty

3rd infringement: Exclusion

11.7 Early check-in at the end of a day

Crews are authorised to check in advance at:

- TC 6C Flexi-Service Out/Parc Fermé In
- TC 12C Flexi-Service Out/Parc Fermé In
- TC 18D Finish of the Rally (Holding area IN, before Podium ceremony)

11.8 Finish Procedure and Finish of the Rally

Finish of the rally will be at TC18D (time control before podium). From this point all cars are subject to Parc Fermé rules and have to follow Marshals instructions.

11.9 Salou - Final Parc Fermé Opening

After results have been declared final on Sunday, 5th October, competitors must remove their cars from the Parc Fermé of Salou, after receiving the authorisation from by the Clerk of the Course.

On Sunday 5th October after the Podium ceremony all crews taking the rally cars to parc fermé will receive a card. This card will have to be handed to the Parc Ferme marshal in order to be able to pick up the car after the parc fermé has been opened.

For Priority 3 and non Priority drivers an Organisation Team will provide information about the road conditions during the rally. Whenever possible such notes will be handed over to each crew before entering the service park.

The maximum speed set for competitors' safety cars is 90km/h except where there is a lower legal limit.

The prizegiving will take place at the finish podium at Passeig Jaume I of Salou, on Sunday, 5th October from 15.10 hrs

If the protest involves several mechanical components, the deposit shall be reckoned by adding up all the amounts specified for each stage. The expenses incurred by the work and by the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if the claim is upheld.



Radio frequencies request fees 350 €

All applications for licences must be received with payment by the Rally Office **before Monday**, 18th **August 2008**.

Manufacturers entered in WRC are exempt from paying when submitting their applications; Radio licences fees are included on Manufacturers Package.

Any infringement of the law will render the breachers liable to proceedings and if their frequencies interfere with the organisation network sanctions **could lead to exclusion**.
